

5.1 Distribution / Eligibility

This Service Bulletin applies to the AV-Link-E accessory with operating software release 0.3.3 or earlier. Use Table 5-1 Applicability to determine applicability of the software update.

Parts identified above as "Verify by procedure" may have software release 0.3.3 or previous installed. To determine what version of software is installed:

- 1. Connect to the AV-Link-E with a PC or Apple® iOS® device following the instructions in Section 8.
- 2. If the AV-Link-E version displayed on the web page is 0.3.3 or earlier, proceed with this Service Bulletin.

5.3 Description

This Service Bulletin provides instructions for loading uAvionix AV-Link-E UAV-1004413-001 with updated software release 0.3.4.

5.4 Time Required

For field software update, up to 30 minutes is required to perform this update procedure.

Click on the link in the section **AV-Link-E v0.3.4 Firmware** and save it to your PC or mobile device.

Ensure the software has been downloaded prior to visiting the aircraft. An internet connection is required to download the software and application. An internet connection is not required to perform the update.

6.1 Windows PC or Apple® iOS® device with Wi-Fi

7 Update Notes

All AV-Link-E configuration settings will be preserved during the update procedure. However, please take note of all settings before performing the update, and verify settings are correct after the update has been applied.

Ensure you are running a previous version of AV-Link-E software. Specifically, your AV-Link-E should be running 0.3.3 or earlier.

8 AV-Link-E Update Procedure


The AV-Link-E acts as a Wi-Fi hotspot to which your PC will connect. If you are using a phone or a tablet, put it in airplane mode first, then enable Wi-Fi to avoid being connected to multiple networks at once.

8.1 Connecting with Wi-Fi

The following illustrations and procedures show the update procedure when using a Windows PC. Apply the same procedures, modified as necessary, when using an iPhone® or iPad®.

NOTE: An AV-Link-E with version 0.3.2 and up will disable its Wi-Fi network after 5 minutes if it is not connected to an AV-30 configured for an AV-Link and no clients have connected. If this occurs, cycle power to the unit.

- Apply power to the AV-30 and AV-Link-E. Do not interrupt power during the update process.
- 2. Connect a PC to the AV-Link-E Wi-Fi Network. This will be displayed as AV-#### where #### will be 4 random characters ranging from 0-8 and A-F.




 In the Web Browser navigate to the AV-Link-E homepage via the following URL: <u>192.168.5.1</u>


NOTE: If your current AV-Link-E software version is 0.2.39 or earlier, the homepage URL will be <u>192.168.4.1</u> instead.

4. At the top of the page in the Settings box, click the link named 0.3.3-AVLink (or whatever your current software version is).



Wi-Fi Settings Statistics





6. Once the file has been selected click (but do not double click!) Start Update. You will see the progress increase in percentage until it reaches 100%. Wait for "Firmware update successful. Rebooting..."




 If updating from version 0.2.39 or earlier, the URL to access the AV-Link web interface will have changed to <u>192.168.5.1</u>.

> Enter that URL to return to the main device page and check that the update was completed.

NOTE: If the AV-Link-E Wi-Fi network does not appear in your connection list, power cycle the AV-Link-E and check again.

After updating to 0.3.2 or later, the AV-Link-E Wi-Fi access point will turn off automatically after 5 minutes if no clients connect to it and there is no connected AV-30 configured to interface with it. Power-cycling the AV-Link-E refreshes this timeout.



9 Post-Accomplishment Verification and Actions

On restart, verify that the web page displays the correct AV-Link-E version number and part number as listed in Table 6-1 Software Update Files.

If all fields match, continue with these instructions. Otherwise, contact uAvionix Support.

NOTE: If the update fails due to a Wi-Fi disconnect, it may help to go to the AV-30's INSTALL menu and switch SERIAL 3 to NONE while attempting to update the AV-Link. Re-enable the setting to AVLINK after the update succeeds. See the Installation Manual in Table 5-2 AV-30-E Documents for instructions on how to change installation settings.
